2021 Midwest Gypsy Horse Association Show Covid-19 Protocol

(Effective 2/1/21, subject to change)

- 1. For the purpose of the possible need for contact tracing, all exhibitors, spectators and volunteers attending the show will be registered with name, address and phone number. Those registered will be identified with a wrist band.
- 2. Individuals at increased risk of severe illness should consider staying at home.
- 3. RV's or trailers parked for camping must be spaced 20 feet apart.
- 4. Fair Park staff will be sanitizing and cleaning touch points in restrooms and showers periodically.
- 5. Show staff will be cleaning door handles and work surfaces every 2 hours.
- 6. Indoor Arena bleachers will be blocked off from being used. Spectators are encouraged to bring their own chairs for seating.
- 7. Face coverings are required in all buildings including, barns, bathrooms, and indoor arenas. When inside; riders, trainers, judges, and announcers should wear face coverings when 6ft social distancing is not possible.
- 8. Personal protective measures are encouraged among exhibitors. spectators and volunteers (e.g., stay home when sick, hand washing, respiratory etiquette, face coverings, physical distancing).
- 9. The Activity Center kitchen will not be open for any food service.
